GRADING

Players' standard August 2021 grades will be used. Ungraded players should give an indication of their playing strength on the back of the entry form.

All results will be submitted to the ECF for grading. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their grading information being published on the ECF website.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The first 36 entries will be guaranteed acceptance, but further entries will only be accepted if space permits. The Director reserves the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.

Mobile phones and electronic devices must be switched off and placed in a closed bag on the floor, or stored at the arbiter's table. If your phone rings during your game you will lose the game.

Any disputes shall be referred to the ECF arbiter whose decision shall be final.

The organizers accept no responsibility for any loss, theft or accident during the tournament. Adult supervision for children taking part will only be provided in the tournament hall.

A qualified first-aider, Francis Bowers, will be on hand and a first aid box is on the premises.

ENTRY FEES

For ECF members (bronze level or above) the entry fee is £20, or £10 for juniors under 18 on 1 November. If you are not an ECF member there is a surcharge of £25.00. Entries received after 13 November will be subject to a £5 surcharge.

PRIZES

The County Champion will hold the County Championship trophy for one year. Cash prizes and momento trophies, to be retained by the winners, will also be given to at least the County Champion, the highest-placed junior and the Challengers winner. The prize fund will depend on entries, and will be announced at the start of play. Titles and trophies will be decided by tiebreak (progressive score, then sum-of-opponents'-scores), but cash prizes will be shared by players on the same number of points.

RATE OF PLAY

70 minutes plus a 15 second increment per move from move 1. Any player arriving more than 30 minutes late for a round will be defaulted and their opponent re-paired if possible.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to play in these championships participants must satisfy one of the following conditions:

- been born in the County
- currently resident in the County
- in full-time education in the County
- a current member of a chess club affiliated to the Association.

VENUE AND DIRECTIONS

From the south leave the A1 at the A605 junction toward the City Centre. Then turn left at the third exit. At the roundabout junction with the A47 (Soke Parkway) turn right and go past the City Hospital on your right. Come off the Parkway at junction 17, go straight on at the roundabout over the railway line to junction 18 where you turn right onto the A15.

Almost immediately filter left, then turn right onto Lincoln Road. After about half a mile just before a pedestrian crossing turn sharp left into the New England Complex and park. The bridge club is accessed off York Road just round the corner.

From the east or west follow directions above from junction 18 of the A47.
