### RATE OF PLAY

Fischer time control: 25 minutes plus 10 second increment from move 1. Any player arriving more than 15 minutes late for a round will be defaulted and their opponent repaired if possible.

### VENUE AND DIRECTIONS

Whittlesford Memorial Hall is just off junction 10 of the M11. From junction 10 (Duxford) take the A505 eastbound toward Newmarket. After a mile turn left at the crossroads into Whittlesford. Mill Lane is three-quarters of a mile on the right, just before you reach a recreation ground and playing fields. The Memorial Hall is on the corner with its own car park.

If approaching from the east on the A505 turn right at the crossroads just after crossing the railway line. This is about three-quarters of a mile after the roundabout with BP/McDonalds services where you cross the Cambridge - Saffron Walden road. Mill Lane is three-quarters of a mile on the right, just before reaching the recreation ground and playing fields. The Memorial Hall is on the corner with its own car park.

Whittlesford is on the Cambridge to Liverpool Street railway line which provides a half-hour service on Sundays. From the station walk from the west (Cambridge-bound) platform for a quarter of a mile to a crossroads. Turn right, and the venue is just over half a mile along that road, on the corner of Mill Lane. Walking from the station should take 15-20 minutes.
